The log showed that the process crashed during startup with error message " invalid picture". Last Friday I have sent out an email on the Vb crashing with the same error. I thought it was a virus attach. Bill said that he tried to gave us call on Friday and indicated that no one was available. We tried to reinstall the vb service pack. The service pack installation gave out of space error on c: drive. The C: drive had only 2K left. This was the actual root cause of the problem. We have cleared some temorary files and the FTP log files to create enough space. The system was started back and all the processes are started fine.
